# Article 2 - Scope

CONTRACTOR OF THE AUTHORNOOPS CONTRACTOR

The Union has decided to grant a financial contribution for the implementation of the project as specified in Annex I, called European cities serving as Green Urban Gate towards Leadership in sustainable Energy, (EU-GUGLE) (the "project") within the framework of the EEB.ENERGY.2012.8.8.3 Demonstration of nearly Zero Energy Building Renovation for cities and districts and under the conditions laid down in this grant agreement.

# Article 3 - Duration and start date of the project

The duration of the project shall be 60 months from 01/04/2013 (hereinafter referred to as the "start date").

#### Article 4 - Reporting periods and language of reports

The project is divided into reporting periods of the following duration:

- P1: from month 1 to month 18.
- P2: from month 19 to month 36,
- P3: from month 37 to month 48,
- Final: from month 49 to the last month of the project.

Any report and deliverable, when appropriate, required by this grant agreement shall be in English.

#### Article 5 - Maximum financial contribution of the Union

- The maximum financial contribution of the Union to the project shall be EUR 16.785.372,00 (sixteen
  million seven hundred and eighty-five thousand three hundred and seventy-two EURO). The
  actual financial contribution of the Union shall be calculated in accordance with the provisions of this
  grant agreement.
- Details of the financial contribution of the Union are contained in Annex I to this grant agreement which includes:
  - a table of the estimated breakdown of budget and financial contribution of the Union per activity
    to be carried out by each of the beneficiaries under the project. Beneficiaries are allowed to
    transfer budget between different activities and between themselves in so far as the work is
    carried out as foreseen in Annex I.
  - a table per beneficiary specifying the budget to be reimbursed as a lump sum. Beneficiarles are
    not allowed to transfer financial contribution of the Union to the part to be reimbursed as a lump
    sum. The latter does not apply to beneficiaries from International Cooperation partner countries.

#### Article 6 - Pre-financing

A pre-financing of EUR 5.874.880,20 (five million eight hundred and seventy-four thousand eight hundred and eighty EURO and twenty cents) shall be paid to the coordinator within 30 days following the date of entry into force of this grant agreement. The coordinator shall distribute the pre-financing only to the beneficiaries who have acceded to the grant agreement and after the minimum number of beneficiaries required by the Rules for Participation as detailed in the call for proposals to which the project is related, have acceded to the grant agreement.

Beneficiaries hereby agree that the amount of EUR 839.268,60 (eight hundred and thirty-nine thousand two hundred and sixty-eight EURO and sixty cents), corresponding to the beneficiaries' contribution to the Guarantee Fund referred to in Article II.20 and representing 5,00% of the maximum financial contribution of the Union referred to in Article 5.1, is transferred in their name by the Commission from the pre-financing into the Guarantee Fund. However, beneficiaries are deemed to have received the full pre-financing referred to in the first indent and will have to justify it in accordance with the grant agreement.

2. These beneficiaries may charge costs incurred by the above-mentioned third parties in carrying out the project, in accordance with the provisions of the grant agreement. These contributions shall not be considered as receipts of the project.

The third parties shall identify the costs to the *project* mutatis mutandis in accordance with the provisions of part B of Annex II of the *grant agreement*. Each third party shall charge its eligible costs in accordance with the principles established in Articles II.14 and II.15.

The beneficiaries shall transmit to the coordinator using the electronic exchange system set up by the Commission:

- an individual financial statement from each third party in the format specified in Form C. These costs shall not be included in the corresponding beneficiary's Form C.
- certificates on the financial statements and/or on the methodology from each third party in accordance with the relevant provisions of this *grant agreement*.

When submitting reports referred to in Article II.4, the *consortium* shall identify work performed and resources deployed by each third party linking it to the corresponding *beneficiary*.

- 3. The eligibility of the third parties' costs charged by the *beneficiaries* is subject to controls and audits of the third parties, in accordance with Articles II.22 and 23.
- 4. The beneficiaries shall retain sole responsibility towards the Union and the other beneficiaries for the third parties linked to it. The beneficiaries shall ensure that the third parties abide by the provisions of the grant agreement.

- 4. In case of refusal of the notification or absence of the recipient, the *beneficiary* or the *consortium*, as the case may be, is deemed to have been notified on the date of the latest delivery, if notification to the coordinator has been sent to one of the addresses mentioned in paragraphs 1 and 3 and to their legal representative. Other *beneficiaries* are deemed to have been notified if notification has been sent to the address mentioned in Article 1.1.

# Article 9 - Applicable law and competent court

The *financial contribution of the Union* is a contribution from the *Union* research budget with the aim to implement the 7th Research Framework Programme (FP7) and it is incumbent on the Commission to execute FP7. Accordingly, this *grant agreement* shall be governed by the terms of this *grant agreement*, the European Community and European Union acts related to FP7, the Financial Regulation applicable to the general budget of *the Union* and its Rules of Application and other European Community and European Union law and, on a subsidiary basis, by the law of *Belglum*.

Furthermore, the *beneficiary* Is aware, and agrees, that the *Commission* may take a decision to impose pecuniary obligations, which shall be enforceable in accordance with Article 299 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and Articles 164 and 192 of the Treaty establishing the *European Atomic Energy Community*.

Notwithstanding the *Commission*'s right to directly adopt the recovery decisions referred to in the previous paragraph, the General Court, or on appeal, the Court of Justice of the European Union, shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any dispute between the *Union* and any *beneficiary* concerning the Interpretation, application or validity of this *grant agreement* and the validity of the decision mentioned in the second paragraph.

#### Article 10 - Application of the grant agreement provisions

Any provision of this part of the *grant agreement*, shall take precedence over the provisions of any of the Annexes. The provisions of Annex III shall take precedence over the provisions of Annex II, and both shall take precedence over the provisions of Annex I.

The special clauses set out in Article 7 shall take precedence over any other provisions of this *grant* agreement.

# Article 11 - Entry into force of the grant agreement

This *grant agreement* shall enter into force after its signature by the *coordinator* and the *Commission*, on the day of the last signature.
